The Role

We are currently recruiting for a Fleet Introduction Engineer to join our Engineering - Rolling Stock team in Wednesbury. The purpose of this role is to ensure the introduction into service of the new CAF Urbos tram fleet.

Role Responsibilities:

- Oversee the day to day testing and commissioning programme being carried out by the 3GT tram manufacturer.
- Chair and lead regular testing and commissioning briefings on behalf of the operator.
- Work closely with the manufacturers engineering and commissioning teams in order to facilitate knowledge transfer.
- Work closely with the owner's team in order to audit the construction of the tram fleet.
- Carry out fleet acceptance inspections in conjunction with the owner's team.
- Working closely with the Technical Trainers and Assessors to develop and deliver training courses on the new tram fleet.
- Support the continued development of the safety management system (SMS) for the new fleet to be introduced into service.
- International travel to Europe is foreseen as part of this role.
