



Proposed Amendment to Penalty Fares on Midland Metro

Have Your Say: Midland Metro operates a Penalty Fare regime whereby any person travelling on the Midland Metro Network without a valid ticket, could be liable to pay a Penalty Fare of £10. Midland Metro is intending to bring in Buy Before You Board in the future and it is felt that the current Penalty Fare is no longer a sufficient deterrent to dissuade ticketless travel.

Proposed Amendment: West Midlands Combined Authority, owner of Midland Metro, submitted a proposed amendment to vary the applicable penalty from £10 to £100 with a reduced penalty of £50 being applicable for early payment (within 14 days) in accordance with the Penalty Fares Act 1991 (as amended by The Midland Metro (Penalty Fares) Order 2019). West Midlands Combined Authority intends to bring the proposed penalty fare into force in the future and would be interested to receive your feedback.
